

Apparently he mis-stepped and fell down an entire flight of stairs (13 to be exact). He was bruised, bleeding and had torn his jeans ... but his main concern was, naturally, for his child.



His fears were alleviated, though, when from behind him he heard a gleeful giggle followed by, "Again!"

Failure happens to all of us. It hurts and it is no fun. The goal in life is not to run from failure, but to deal with it head on. That is the key. Peter denied Christ three times but repents and comes to be the leader of the early church. Judas betrayed Jesus. He despairs and hangs himself. I believe Christ would have forgiven him if he humbly asked for forgiveness. Two totally different responses.

We all get knocked down, but not all of us get back up. You can't surrender to failure, pain or disappointment. By God's grace, we can rise above it. Life isn't easy. We will go through seasons of difficulty. Don't give in, get up and live Again!
