DISCOURAGEMENT - PAUL STANLEY, KISS

Hey vou rockers, do you remember Paul Stanley of the band Kiss? He had an unusual start to his musical career. It began with him watching the Beatles on the Ed Sullivan **Show**. As he watched the Fab Four, he had an epiphany.

As he described it, "LOOK, I'M A LITTLE FAT KID WHO'S DEAF ON ONE SIDE, HAS A DEFORMITY, AND I SEE THIS BAND ON ED SULLIVAN, AND I JUST WENT, "I CAN DO THAT. I MAY NOT BE ABLE TO BE THEM, BUT I CAN TOUCH THAT NERVE".

His enthusiasm outweighed his talent. His parents wanted his sister and him to develop their musical skill. They had a problem. They could not afford to send his

sister and him to music lessons at the same time. They decided to send his sister first for mandolin lessons. After a few months, they took her out of the school to give Paul the opportunity to learn the guitar. After only one month, the teacher told him, "Tell your parents that we will take your sister back for free if you quit!" Not the most encouraging message.

Are you an encourager or discourager? It is easy to find fault, to complain and criticize. It takes grace and effort to focus on the positive. There are plenty of things to complain about in the world today. It requires no imagination to point out the negative. We, as Christ followers, place our attention on the good. As St. Paul tells us "whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things." (Phil.4:8)

Make a commitment this summer to speak in a positive voice. Focus on what is right, not what is wrong. Be an encourager, not a discourager.

Como nos dice San Pablo "todo lo que es verdadero, todo lo que es noble, todo lo que es justo, todo lo que es puro, todo lo que es amable, todo lo que es digno de admiración - si hay algo excelente o digno de alabanza- pensad en tales cosas". 




