

My Take



A month or so ago, an older post of Pope Francis came up on my social media. In this post, Pope Francis rebutted the argument that abortion can be justified as a solution to the crisis of pregnancy by stating "Is it right to take a human life to solve a problem? It's like hiring a hitman." Wow, what a powerful statement. I have been reflecting on this and thinking I need to write about this.

On Saturday, December 28th, we commemorated the Feast of the Holy Innocents. I remember Deacon Joe speaking about the massacre and compared it to the killing

of innocents during our day. As Mother Teresa reminds us, the unborn child is the "poorest of the poor", the child has no choice.

According to WHO (World Health Organization), there are estimated to be between 40-50 million abortions worldwide a year. Behind the pro-choice is a child loved by God and waiting to fulfill his/her destiny. What wonderful things or cures might one of these children have discovered?

Although as I stated earlier, Pope Francis did speak out strongly about abortion, the Catholic faith does offer forgiveness and the invitation to reconcile with God. If you know of a woman feeling guilty about her past, invite her to church to participate in the sacrament of confession. Here she can ask forgiveness from the child and look forward to the reunion in heaven.

I'm anxious for 2025 to get underway. We still have work to do on buildings and on our call to discipleship. I still have a lot of work to do on me and growing my faith. Thank you, God, for bringing me this far, I can't wait to see where you lead me.




THANKS TO OUR "St. Theresa Decorating Elves"
