



FROM FATHER TOM

I was walking Moses early morning in the church parking lot. As I head toward the church, I spot a car driving in making the left and heading towards our back gate. I assume we are now a shortcut for those

living behind us. As I stroll with Moses, I arrive at that turn spot. Immediately

I am hit by this wave of cigarette smoke. I could swear that I am standing by a smoker. I look around; there is no one there. From where is it coming? It dawns on me - the car. In that brief moment, that split second, despite the cool fresh air, the tobacco scent is pervasive. It was impossible to avoid. You know something? I bet he/she is not even aware of it. They are so used to it that they become unaware of the odor. It is the norm.

This is not a diatribe against smokers. I have my own issues. What it does make me realize is that we all carry an aroma, a scent. Wherever we go, we bring it with us. Probably like the smoker, we are unaware of it. It, too, is our norm. We can carry an aroma of kindness, positivity and joy. When we leave the room, that aroma also lingers. We make it a better place. We can also carry the aroma of negativity, criticism and complaint. That, too, unfortunately lingers.

What aroma do you wish to carry? Do you want to build up or tear down? Find fault or find the blessing? Look for the good or focus on the negative? The choice is yours. I, for one, want to carry the sweet aroma of God's goodness. I hope you do too.

Moisés, llego a ese punto de giro. Inmediatamente me golpea esta ola de humo de cigarrillo. Podría jurar que estoy al lado de un fumador. Miro a mi

alrededor; No hay nadie allí. ¿De dónde viene? Me doy cuenta: el coche. En ese breve momento, esa fracción de segundo, a pesar del aire fresco y fresco, el aroma a tabaco es omnipresente. My Take

It's early on Saturday afternoon. I operated the screens for a funeral this morning so instead of going home for a few hours and coming back for 4 pm mass, I prefer to take this time to enjoy a VERY quiet office, other than the birds in Father Tom's office. :)

I put music on my phone and just try to reflect on my work. Sometimes, the music will stop my work because the words make me reflect. Those songs today have included Somebody Prayed by Crowder, Belovedness by Sarah Kroger, I Was Gonna Be by Rachel Holt and What If by Consumed by Fire.

- ⇒ I went from thanking God for all I have and missed because someone prayed for me.
- ⇒ To being reminded that God smiled when he made me, and he finds me beautiful. I need to stop having shame or being focused on failures.
- ⇒ To feeling the sadness of a child being aborted and "sent back to heaven on a starlight flight."
- ⇒ To being reminded that God's waiting for me to discover just how big he is.

Father Tom's homily this past weekend focused on how one decision could change your direction. So true. Prior to coming to St Theresa, I worked for Mending Fences, a substance abuse treatment facility, located on a 300 acre horse farm. I loved that job. I could look out my window and see the horses running. I was also lucky that an employee who lived on the farm brought his dog, Sierra, to the office every day. If she was sunning in the lobby and someone walked in my office, she immediately came and laid down. If I had a meeting on site, she went with me. At night, she went home with her father.

In February/March of 2018, the new owner decided to get rid of management and I was let go. Two months later, St Theresa was hiring an Operations Manager so I decided to apply. I knew nothing about working for a church but over the years, I've come to know and love all about this church: the staff, my boss, the parishioners, the volunteers and more. When I stop to think about what I would have missed if I was still working at Mending Fences. I wouldn't be here nor would I, probably, have returned to my Catholic Faith.

Es temprano el sábado por la tarde. Operé las pantallas para un funeral esta mañana, así que en lugar de irme a casa por unas horas y regresar para la misa de las 4 pm, prefiero aprovechar este tiempo para disfrutar de una oficina MUY tranquila, aparte de los pájaros en la oficina del padre Tom.

Pongo música en mi teléfono y trato de reflexionar sobre mi trabajo. A veces, la música detiene mi trabajo porque las palabras me hacen reflexionar. Esas canciones de hoy han incluido Somebody Prayed de Crowder, Belovedness de Sarah Kroger, I Was Gonna Be de Rachel Holt y What If de Consumed by Fire.

Pasé de agradecerle a Dios por todo lo que tengo y me perdí porque alguien oró por mí. A recordar que Dios sonrió cuando me creó y me encuentra hermosa. Necesito dejar de sentir vergüenza o concentrarme en los fracasos.

A sentir la tristeza de un niño que es abortado y "enviado de regreso al cielo en un vuelo de luz de estrellas". A recordar que Dios está esperando que descubra cuán grande es.

La homilía del padre Tom del fin de semana pasado se centró en cómo una decisión puede cambiar tu rumbo. Muy cierto. Antes de venir a St Theresa, trabajé para Mending Fences, un centro de tratamiento de abuso de sustancias, ubicado en una granja de caballos de 300 acres. Me encantaba ese trabajo. Podía mirar por la ventana y ver a los caballos correr. También tuve la suerte de que un empleado que vivía en la granja trajera a su perro, Sierra, a la oficina todos los días. Si estaba tomando sol en el vestíbulo y alguien entraba en mi oficina, inmediatamente venía y se acostaba. Si tenía una reunión en el lugar, ella iba conmigo. Por la noche, se iba a casa con su padre.

En febrero/marzo de 2018, el nuevo propietario decidió deshacerse de la gerencia y me despidieron. Dos meses después, St Theresa estaba contratando a un gerente de operaciones, así que decidí postularme. No sabía nada sobre trabajar para una iglesia, pero con los años, llegué a conocer y amar todo sobre esta iglesia: el personal, mi jefe, los feligreses, los voluntarios y más. Cuando me detengo a pensar en lo que me habría perdido si hubiera seguido trabajando en Mending Fences, no estaría aquí y probablemente no habría regresado a mi fe católica.
