



## FROM FATHER TOM

It happened the same Friday night I was serving pizza at WAWA for our Social Service guests. Sitting alone was this forlorn chap looking tired and dejected. He was carrying two gas containers for his car. Evidently, he ran out of gas. There he sat. I assumed he was taking a break. I offered him some pizza. Refusing at first, but with a little prodding, he gladly took one and then another. I moved on, looking after our guests. Thirty minutes later he was still sitting there.



Curious, I asked "how long do you plan on sitting there?" "I have no money," he replied. Oh! I wanted to tell him that sitting there is not going to put gas in the car. "Why didn't you say something?" Silence. "Grab your container and let's get some gas. He jumps up and we head to the pump and fill his container. If he had only mentioned it sooner, we could have gone and filled up his car. Oh well, at least he had enough to get where he needed to go.

People are not *mind readers*. How often do we expect people to know what we are thinking? I know firsthand. I make that very mistake. They should know, we insist. No, not really. We need to speak up. We need to tell people what we are thinking and feeling. We expect them to be able to know our thoughts, and when they don't, we become disappointed, if not angry.

Of course, there is a right way in expressing our thoughts. No blaming. No attacking. No game playing. What is quite helpful is admitting that we need help. Don't expect others, no matter how close the relationship, to read your mind. It is that simple.







# My Take

I live in Ocala so my drive to St Theresa can take about 35 minutes or so. I don't mind the drive as I get to check in on cows and horses and one farm has a draft horse, donkey, and a couple of goats. Until January, I spent my time listening to music on Z88. Then I decided to make my time more productive and started listening to The Bible in a

Year with Fr. Mike Schmitz. Each day he'll read chapters in Genesis all the way to Revelations. You can find the podcast here <a href="https://www.youtube.com/playlist?list=PLeXS0cAkuTPqFMtZQ379qdEmcfxO1SvXc">https://www.youtube.com/playlist?list=PLeXS0cAkuTPqFMtZQ379qdEmcfxO1SvXc</a> or several other websites. Each of the 14 narrative books are read along with a coinciding book, such as legal, prophetic, poetic or New Testament epistle and a psalm or proverb, closing with a guided prayer. At the end of the 365 episodes, you'll understand how all the pieces fit together.

I'm using the app Podcast to listen during my daily commute. I find this method of covering the Bible preferrable to reading at home. There are distractions at home. Not only do I enjoy hearing the Bible read but after each session, Fr. Mike Schmitz will key in on a part of that day's reading and offer a reflection. For instance, did you know that each of the plagues sent by God on the Pharaoh and the people of Egypt were not just random disasters? There were each against Egyptian gods. For example, the plague of blood was against Hapi and Osiris, which were considered the gods of the Nile, and the plague of darkness was against Ra, who was the Egyptian god of the sun.

What has this podcast done for my faith? It's strengthened it. It's great to hear the bible read and Fr. Mike's explanations and his love and compassion for the word of God can't be missed. Starting my day with the Bible podcast had given me time to myself to hear and reflect on the words of God which has instilled peace at the beginning of my day. When I learn something new, I could not wait to share it with others at the office. Join me on this journey and share the word with others.



Cada uno de los 14 libros narrativos se lee junto con un libro coincidente, como una epístola legal, profética, poética o del Nuevo Testamento y un salmo o proverbio, y se cierra con una oración quiada.

Uso la aplicación Podcast para escuchar durante mi viaje diario al trabajo. Este método de estudio de la Biblia me parece preferible a leer en casa. En casa hay distracciones. No solo disfruto de escuchar la lectura de la Biblia, sino que después de cada sesión, el padre Mike Schmitz se centra en una parte de la lectura del día y ofrece una reflexión. Por ejemplo, ¿sabías que cada una de las plagas enviadas por Dios al faraón y al pueblo de Egipto no fueron solo desastres aleatorios? Todas fueron contra los dioses egipcios. Por ejemplo, la plaga de sangre fue contra Hapi y Osiris, que eran considerados los dioses del Nilo, y la plaga de la oscuridad fue contra Ra, que era el dios egipcio del sol.

¿Qué ha hecho este podcast por mi fe? La ha fortalecido. Es genial escuchar la lectura de la Biblia y las explicaciones del padre Mike y su amor y compasión por la palabra de Dios son imprescindibles. Comenzar el día con el podcast de la Biblia me ha dado tiempo para escuchar y reflexionar sobre las palabras de Dios, lo que me ha infundido paz al comenzar el día. Cuando aprendo algo nuevo, no veo la hora de compartirlo con los demás en la oficina. Únase a mí en este viaje y comparta la palabra con los demás.


