



FROM FATHER TOM

Happiness, we all want it, yet too few have it. Before anything else, walk with God. Live according to His truth. Then consider these ten tips.





1. **Holding grudges**. They're actually kind of heavy. That's where the term chip on the shoulder comes from. Let them go and lighten the load.

- 2. **Comparing yourself to others**. It's a waste of time because no one is the unique blend that you are. Instead, work on discovering and enhancing your unique blend. That will bring your gifts to the world.
- 3. **Worrying about the future**. The future is actually an illusion. The past is now delusion, so just focus on the here and now.
- 4. **Perfectionism**. It's one of the greatest causes of depression.
- 5. **Negative self-talk**. Listen to what you're saying to yourself and make sure it's positive. You are your own best friend or worst enemy. Definitely become the friend.
- 6. **Dwelling on past mistakes**. Instead of dwelling on them, just learn the lesson and then grow and move on.
- 7. The need to please everyone. People pleasing will get you nowhere except a lot of phony relationships.
- 8. **Fear of change**. Fear is often a sign actually to go forward, especially if it's just our own limiting beliefs that are holding us back. So yeah, don't let fear ever stop you.
- 9. **Regret**. Regret is also another emotional waste of time. You want to simply learn the lesson, not sit there regretting, which will just inject cortisol. That's the hormone of stress throughout your body.
- 10. And finally, **happy people don't worry about what other people think of them**. They worry about what they think of themselves. So make sure what you're doing in your private and public life is something you're happy about, proud about. Then it really doesn't matter what other people think.



- 3. **Preocuparse por el futuro**. El futuro es en realidad una ilusión. El pasado es ahora una ilusión, así que céntrate en el aquí y ahora.
- 4. **Perfeccionismo**. Es una de las mayores causas de depresión.
- 5. **Habla negativamente de ti mismo**. Escucha lo que te dices a ti mismo y asegúrate de que sea positivo. Usted es su mejor amigo o su peor enemigo. Definitivamente, conviértete en el amigo.
- 6. Recordar los errores del pasado. En lugar de insistir en ellos, aprende la lección y luego crece y sigue adelante.
- 7. **La necesidad de complacer a todo el mundo**. Complacer a la gente no te llevará a ninguna parte, excepto a un montón de relaciones falsas.
- 8. **Miedo al cambio**. El miedo es a menudo una señal para seguir adelante, sobre todo si son nuestras propias creencias limitantes las que nos frenan. Así que sí, no dejes que el miedo te detenga nunca.


When we have bad days, we like to think that God's busy elsewhere and didn't have time to make sure the bridge was open or that Pendragon wasn't sitting on my keys or that this person or that didn't need a problem resolved. But that's not what God does. God makes the good and the bad days. He knows that we are self-reliant and if we only had good days, we might and sometimes do, leave Him on the fringe. He doesn't want us to depend on today was a good day so tomorrow will be a good one too.

God is not dependent on us, but we are dependent on him. He can make a crop grow or a flower bloom at the arctic circle in the middle of a storm. But if we want him to help us, we must take some responsibility for ourselves. For example, if we want our field to grow so we can harvest it, we must first plant the seeds. Then we are dependent on God for the rain to water it and the sun to shine.

While the bad days may be hard at the time, we must remember that God is aware. He's using the hard days to help accomplish His plans for us and to make us reliant on him. Remember if God brings you to it; He will bring you through it.

Dental Clinic


