The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ Give Them Some Food Yourselves

The Gospel for this feast reminds me of what my aunt used to tell us when we would visit her and share a meal. Her favorite saying was, "If you don't get enough to eat, it's your own fault." Perhaps Jesus would say the same as he feeds us with his Body and Blood.

Some say that the multiplication of loaves was not done by breaking the laws of physics. Instead, they say that Jesus, when he began to share the little bread that he had, touched the hearts of all those who had brought food with them. They followed his example by sharing their food also—so much that there were twelve baskets left over.

Jesus came to change people's hearts, to show them God's love and how to love one another. The miracle of changing bread and wine into his Body and Blood is not just so we can feel good about having Jesus so near to us. It is meant to strengthen us to do our best as his disciples. As food and drink help us to keep on working, his Body and Blood help us to keep on loving.

When the disciples told Jesus about the hungry crowd, he told them, "Give them some food yourselves" (Luke 9:13). And one day they would. When they celebrated the Eucharist after Jesus' resurrection, they gave that spiritual food to the new followers of Christ. We continue that today. The other day, a glass slipped through my fingers and shattered on the floor. Fortunately, I was wearing shoes so as I moved around the shattered glass, I didn't step on any. I quickly tried to sweep up all the pieces before my husband, Tom, or my cat, Pendragon, stepped on any. I hate when you think you've found it all and then later that day or the next, you step on a small piece and for a minute you're in a bit of discomfort.

I think life is a lot like this. Sometimes, your life gets shattered by the loss of a job or a home, a divorce or the death of a loved one. Just like shattered glass, try as you might, you can never put life back into place quite the same. Somedays you may feel as if you have, but it just takes one step, onto a missed piece of glass or forgotten memory, to bring the pain and heartbreak back into focus.

In your pain, remember that God is still beside you. Having difficult days helps us to remember God's grace and love. It may help you also to understand that God's plans reach far beyond what we imagine our life is or should be. Your pain could be the thing that draws you into a closer relationship with God and others in the same situation. Take your broken glass to God and trust him to heal you.
