"No problem," said the man. "I count until three - and then I sleep."


"And that works every time?" asks the waiter surprised.

My Take



In Panama, there is a small town called Portobello, which is located on the Caribbean coast. Around 1658, a statue of a dark-skinner depiction of Jesus, washed up on shore. The Spanish tried to ship the statue out to other locations, but the statue always floated back to Portobello. The "Black Christ" as it is now known is in the San Felipe Church.



Every year as many as 60,000 devotees will begin a walking pilgrimage to Portobello and when they arrive at the small town, they crawl the rest of the way to be there for the Feast Day on Oct. 21st. After a day of praying and worshiping in the church, the statue is brought out on a platform and men carry the statue through the town arriving

back at the church at midnight. The men carrying the platform will take three steps forward and two back, like Spanish religious processions.

Why do I tell this story? One, I have had the pleasure to go to Portobello, many times when I lived in Panama, to visit the statue in the church. Two, the stories told about the miracles that have been performed have reminded me that with God all things are possible. Three, because the procession often reminds me that my life is a journey with victories and setbacks. It encourages me to persevere in my walk to increase my faith, reminding me that setbacks are not forever and my overall progress will always be possible.

The same journey that has brought me moments of shame has also brought me moments of gratitude when I shout my thanksgiving to God for giving me my life, my family and my church.

En Panamá, hay un pequeño pueblo llamado Portobello, ubicado en la costa caribeña. Alrededor de 1658, una estatua de Jesús de piel oscura apareció en la orilla. Los españoles intentaron transportar la estatua a otros lugares, pero siempre regresaba flotando a Portobello. El "Cristo Negro", como se le conoce ahora, se encuentra en la Iglesia de San Felipe.



Cada año, hasta 60,000 devotos comienzan una peregrinación a pie a Portobello y, al llegar al pequeño pueblo, recorren a gatas el resto del camino para estar allí para la festividad del 21 de octubre. Después de un día de oración y adoración en la iglesia, la estatua se saca en una plataforma y unos hombres la cargan por el pueblo, regresando a la iglesia a la medianoche. Los hombres que cargan la plataforma dan tres pasos hacia adelante y dos hacia atrás, como en las procesiones religiosas españolas.

¿Por qué cuento esta historia? Primero, he tenido el placer de ir a Portobello muchas veces cuando vivía en Panamá a visitar la estatua en la iglesia.

Segundo, las historias de los milagros que se han realizado me han recordado que con Dios todo es posible. Tercero, porque la procesión a menudo me recuerda que mi vida es un camino con victorias y reveses. Me anima a perseverar en mi camino para fortalecer mi fe, recordándome que los reveses no son para siempre y que mi progreso general siempre será posible.

El mismo camino que me ha traído momentos de vergüenza también me ha traído momentos de gratitud al expresar mi gratitud a Dios por darme la vida, mi familia y mi iglesia.
