Jonathan Roumie's Experience on ABC's 'The View': 'I Gave Rosaries to Everybody' Last year, well-known Catholic actor Jonathan Roumie was a guest on the ABC talk show, "The View." That took courage. Roumie discussed his role as Jesus on the



hit series, "*The Chosen*," and how his life has changed because of it. "I think for a millisecond I was like, 'Oh, I wonder how this is going to go,'" Roumie shares. "But I was never worried. I prayed about it, of course."

The Catholic actor added that just like "everything else that I've committed to on this journey, I have to surrender it." "I'm like, 'Lord, you've given me this opportunity. It must be for a reason.' So, I'm not going to worry about the consequences; I'm not going to worry about anything. I'm just going to go authentically be who you made me to and just be present to people," he says.

Roumie goes on to say that the response was "overwhelming". Roumie shares that after the segment, he spoke with each of the show's hosts and gave them rosaries, which they all "happily accepted." After his experience, Roumie points out that he realized that "there are so many people that are just on a journey."

"They're searching," he explains. "They may not necessarily believe, they may not necessarily know what to expect, but they're searching, and they were open to what I was bringing to them through the Holy Spirit."

Wow, pretty brave of him. He walked into a hornet's nest. I admire his commitment and lack of fear. He decided to be just himself. Be genuine. Let God lead. As you see, he handed out rosaries. I am sure that never happened before. May Jonathan Roumie encourage us to live out our faith. Be who we are with no apologies but with kindness and respect.

La experiencia de Jonathan Roumie en "The View" de ABC: Le di rosarios a todo el mundo



A principios de este año, el conocido actor católico Jonathan Roumie fue invitado al programa de entrevistas de ABC, "The View". Eso requirió valor. Roumie habló de su papel de Jesús en la exitosa serie "Los elegidos" y de cómo ha cambiado su vida gracias a ello. "Creo que durante un milisegundo pensé: 'Oh, me pregunto cómo va a ir esto'", dice Roumie. "Pero nunca me preocupé. Recé por ello, por supuesto".

El actor católico añadió que al igual que «todo lo demás a lo que me he

comprometido en este viaje, tengo que entregarlo." "Me digo: 'Señor, me has dado esta oportunidad. Debe ser por alguna razón'. Así que no voy a preocuparme por las consecuencias; no voy a preocuparme por nada. Sólo voy a ser auténticamente quien tú me hiciste y a estar presente para la gente", dice.

Roumie añade que la respuesta fue "abrumadora". Roumie cuenta que, después del segmento, habló con cada uno de los presentadores del programa y les regaló rosarios, que todos "aceptaron encantados".

Después de su experiencia, Roumie señala que se dio cuenta de que «hay tanta gente que simplemente está en un viaje". "Están buscando", explica. "Puede que no necesariamente crean, puede que no necesariamente sepan qué esperar, pero están buscando, y estaban abiertos a lo que yo les traía a través del Espíritu Santo".

Vaya, muy valiente por su parte. Se metió en un avispero. Admiro su compromiso y su falta de miedo. Decidió ser él mismo. Ser genuino. Dejarse guiar por Dios. Como ven, repartió rosarios. Estoy seguro de que eso no había ocurrido nunca. Que Jonathan Roumie nos anime a vivir nuestra fe. Ser quienes somos sin disculpas, pero con amabilidad y respeto.

My Take



As a child, I loved to lay on my back and watch the clouds float by. I imagined that I could see the angels, up on the clouds, running around doing whatever they needed to do. I always tried to find loved ones that had passed on, but I guess my imagination just wasn't good enough to see them.



As I've gotten older, I still like to look at clouds, not so much to find the angels, but to find animals, forms and people in them. The other day, I saw a choir of three members singing.

I know most of us love a sunny day without the clouds, but God has a way of using clouds for showing his presence. Remember that God placed a rainbow in the clouds to show Noah he will never flood the earth again. God also used a cloud to lead his people out of Egypt and through the wilderness. When Moses went up on Mount Sinai, God covered the mountain in clouds. God drew close to the disciples in a cloud on the Mount of Transfiguration.

In scripture, clouds symbolize the presence of God and inform us that we will see the son of man coming in a cloud with power and great glory (Luke 21:27). On the next cloudy day, let the child within emerge and try to find the animals, shapes and angels hidden with the clouds. You might be amazed to see God speaking to you with a cloud shaped like his hand, the bright presence of light shining through or, as in the case in 2018, many people recorded a man walking through the clouds. Stop and reflect that the clouds remind us of God's presence and the promise of Jesus' return.
