

#### FROM FATHER TOM

That brought me back to earth... I woke in the morning and grabbed my phone. Unknown to me, the bishop called a little before eleven. By then, I was fast asleep. Too early to return the call. I waited. I was curious. Why would the bishop call me, especially at that time of night? Obviously he is unaware of my sleep schedule. Then it

dawned on me. He wanted me to preach at Fr. Frank Zammit's funeral. He died earlier that day. I had the good fortune of being with him as he took his last breath. It made sense that he wanted me to preach.

Fr. Frank and I worked together for fifteen years at my last assignment. Though retired, he was a great help to me and the parish. In many ways, similar to the Monsignor Jim who assisted here for many years. Fr. Frank and I had an understanding that I would preach at his funeral. That is not the only reason. A month earlier, I preached at Monsignor Page's funeral. The bishop was in attendance. If I can be honest, it was one of the better homilies that I have given. Bishop Noonan even complimented me on it. Aware of my ability, he was now calling to make sure that I preach at Father Frank's funeral. Or so I thought.

Later that morning, I called the Bishop. "Good morning Bishop. I see that you called last night and I am returning your call." There was a moment's pause. I waited for the request. I did not want to sound too anxious but yet ready to jump at the chance to preach at the funeral.

"Oh, it is nothing. At times, when I charge my phone at night, it hits a number on my phone." My heart sank. You mean I was not on the top of the list to preach at this special occasion? Just in case, I told him I was heading home on Tuesday for vacation with my family. I hinted if we can have the funeral on Monday. No luck. The funeral fell on Wednesday. I will not only **not** be preaching but now, unable to attend the funeral mass. Oh well, that taught me a lesson.

That's okay. I love what I do. I am at home here at St. Theresa. I appreciate your kindness and acceptance of me. I trust God is pleased as well. After all, isn't that what's all that matters?

El 23 de agosto de 2020, mis artículos cambiaron de "Proyecto de Crecimiento" a "Mi Opinión", lo que me permitió compartir mi camino de fe con todos ustedes. Fui abierto y honesto sobre mi falta de conocimiento y fe, y cómo los estaba mejorando. A medida que descubrí nuevos recursos e ideas, pude compartirlos con ustedes, como el diario de fe, el significado de las diferentes velas en Adviento, el uso de Formed.org, las señales de nuestra bendición mediante el Sermón del Monte de Jesús, diferentes aplicaciones bíblicas como Halo y otras.

En los últimos siete años y medio, he encontrado amigos que me han acompañado en mi lucha familiar por la salud de mi sobrina, la muerte de dos de mis hermanos, la hospitalización de mi esposo y mi miedo a no ser lo suficientemente buena para Dios. Nunca podría agradecerles por ser esa familia para mí y permitirme acompañarlos cuando lo necesité. Lo que parece ser el final puede ser un nuevo comienzo. Que este nuevo comienzo me ayude a avanzar en mi camino hacia Dios.



#### **DEL PADRE TOM**

Eso me devolvió a la realidad... Me desperté por la mañana y cogí mi teléfono. Sin saberlo, el obispo había llamado poco antes de las once. Para entonces, yo estaba profundamente dormido. Era demasiado temprano para devolver la llamada. Esperé. Tenía curiosidad. ¿Por qué me llamaría el obispo, especialmente a esa hora de la noche? Obviamente, no conocía mis horarios de sueño. Entonces caí en la cuenta. Quería que

predicara en el funeral del padre Frank Zammit. Había fallecido ese mismo día. Tuve la suerte de estar con él cuando exhaló su último aliento. Tenía sentido que quisiera que yo predicara.

El padre Frank y yo trabajamos juntos durante quince años en mi último destino. Aunque estaba jubilado, fue de gran ayuda para mí y para la parroquia. En muchos aspectos, era similar al monseñor Jim, que prestó sus servicios aquí durante muchos años. El padre Frank y yo habíamos acordado que yo predicaría en su funeral. Esa no es la única razón. Un mes antes, prediqué en el funeral del monseñor Page. El obispo asistió al funeral. Si puedo ser sincero, fue una de las mejores homilías que he pronunciado. El obispo Noonan incluso me felicitó por ella. Consciente de mi capacidad, ahora me llamaba para asegurarse de que predicara en el funeral del padre Frank. O eso creía yo.

Más tarde esa mañana, llamé al obispo. «Buenos días, obispo. Veo que me llamó anoche y le devuelvo la llamada». Hubo una pausa. Esperé la petición. No quería parecer demasiado ansioso, pero estaba listo para aprovechar la oportunidad de predicar en el funeral.

«Oh, no es nada. A veces, cuando cargo mi teléfono por la noche, marca un número de mi agenda». Se me encogió el corazón. ¿Quería decir que no era el primero de la lista para predicar en esta ocasión especial? Por si acaso, le dije que el martes me iba a casa de vacaciones con mi familia. Insinué si podíamos celebrar el funeral el lunes. No hubo suerte. El funeral fue el miércoles. No solo no voy a predicar, sino que ahora tampoco podré asistir a la misa fúnebre. Bueno, eso me enseñó una lección.

No pasa nada. Me encanta lo que hago. Me siento como en casa aquí, en Santa Teresa. Agradezco su amabilidad y su aceptación. Confío en que Dios también esté contento. Al fin y al cabo, ¿no es eso lo único que importa?




