He was a Catholic priest but no longer. He is now a married Episcopal priest working in the Midwest. We are in a mutual Facebook group. Our differences are pronounced. We differ in our theology, politics and our view of the world. Boy, are we different. Some of the things he posts on Facebook gets a rise out of me. I choose not to comment. Who needs the hassle? But I did the other day. Jim is a New York Giants Football fan. He celebrated with delight the Giants manhandling, their arch rivals the Eagles. I joined him in his celebration. I was hoping that he would reply back to me. He didn't. All I got was a thumbs up emoji. I'll take it. It is better than nothing.

Why am I telling you this? It would be so easy to write him off. You go your way and I will go mine. As we are friends only on Facebook, neither of us would notice. I like to think my small comment on the Giants winning formed a connection, admittedly a minor one but still a connection. I want to seek areas that we can agree on. If it is not necessary don't focus on the differences, major as they may be. Look for common bonds.

I hope you can do the same. It is not always easy. It can be a struggle. Let's do our best to keep the line of communication open. It is far too easy to cancel each other. Find areas where you can share a common interest or cause. Now if only the Giants can beat those Cowboys.

St. Theresa Weekend Masses

4 pm Saturday:

Our vigil service features music led by Piano and a Cantor, and contains hymns that are commonly seen in today's services, both Traditional and Contemporary.

7:30 am Sunday:

A traditional "High Mass" that features Organ and Choir. Latin chant is used for much of the music at this Mass, as well as traditional hymns, and classical pieces. Incense is also used frequently at this Mass.

9 am Sunday:

This is an upbeat and lively "Family Mass" that features a full Gospel Choir and instrument ensemble. Our Children's Choir sings at this Mass on occasion.

11 am Sunday:

A Mass that contains a mix of contemporary and traditional music led by acoustic guitar and containing a small music ensemble with folk leanings.

5 pm Sunday (Begins Nov. 2nd) A Mass that features Contemporary Christian Music, and a modern Worship Band, as well as many volunteers from our Youth Group. A time of Praise and Worship starts at 4:30 pm before the Mass.
