Blind Spots

As a female and a person of color, I have often been judged well before I opened my mouth. Having experienced this throughout my life, I have worked to recognize my own unconscious biases (a.k.a. "blind spots") so as not to make someone else feel different or unwelcome, the feelings that so often came from these unintentional judgement calls.

But I'm human. And I still fall culprit to unconscious bias, something we all possess that develops over a lifetime of experiences. It's a part of who we are and influences the way we live and the choices we make. And while our unconscious biases help us make good decisions and prevent us from making the same mistakes over again, unconscious bias can work against us if it creates barriers, disconnects us from others, and/or causes us to exclude or reject others *without realizing it*.

Just this past weekend, I found myself fall into it. I went someplace I frequent often, however, the person that came to take care of me was not someone I was familiar with. As she walked over to me, her appearance gave me the impression the service she'd offer would be poor. When I realized how I was quick to judge her and, as a result, dismiss her capability, I immediately changed my approach and engaged with her differently. ...as if she was someone I already knew, as if she was my *sister*. It turned out the care she gave was exceptional - what's more, I appreciated the interaction we had. Would I have recognized her great work and enjoyed the conversation if my blind spot remained? Probably not.

Let's break down barriers to build bridges, let's find common ground when it appears there is none. It may take effort, but as my grandma used to say, "anything in life worth having or attaining or doing will *always* take effort."

Being an example of our Lord will always take effort; let's remind ourselves that connecting with others to spread the Good News will always be worthwhile.

And if everyone is a child of God, every interaction deserves effort.

Puntos ciegos

Como mujer y persona de color, a menudo me han juzgado antes incluso de abrir la boca. Habiendo experimentado esto a lo largo de mi vida, he trabajado para reconocer mis propios prejuicios inconscientes (también conocidos como «puntos ciegos») para no hacer que otra persona se sienta diferente o rechazada, sentimientos que a menudo surgían de estos juicios involuntarios.

Pero soy humana. Y sigo siendo culpable de prejuicios inconscientes, algo que todos poseemos y que se desarrolla a lo largo de toda una vida de experiencias. Es parte de lo que somos e influye en nuestra forma de vivir y en las decisiones que tomamos. Y aunque nuestros prejuicios inconscientes nos ayudan a tomar buenas decisiones y nos impiden cometer los mismos errores una y otra vez, los prejuicios inconscientes pueden jugar en nuestra contra si crean barreras, nos desconectan de los demás y/o nos llevan a excluir o rechazar a otros sin darnos cuenta.

El fin de semana pasado, me di cuenta de que había caído en ello. Fui a un lugar al que voy a menudo, pero la persona que vino a atenderme no era alguien con quien estuviera familiarizada. Cuando se acercó a mí, su apariencia me dio la impresión de que el servicio que me ofrecería sería deficiente. Cuando me di cuenta de lo rápido que la había juzgado y, como resultado, había descartado su capacidad, cambié inmediatamente mi enfoque y me relacioné con ella de manera diferente... como si fuera alguien a quien ya conocía, como si fuera mi hermana. Resultó que la atención que me prestó fue excepcional; es más, aprecié la interacción que tuvimos. ¿Habría reconocido su gran trabajo y disfrutado de la conversación si mi punto ciego hubiera permanecido? Probablemente no.

Derribemos las barreras para tender puentes, encontremos puntos en común cuando parezca que no los hay. Puede que requiera esfuerzo, pero como solía decir mi abuela: «Todo lo que vale la pena tener, alcanzar o hacer en la vida siempre requiere esfuerzo».

Ser un ejemplo de nuestro Señor siempre requerirá esfuerzo; recordemos que conectar con los demás para difundir la Buena Nueva siempre valdrá la pena.

Y si todos somos hijos de Dios, cada interacción merece esfuerzo.

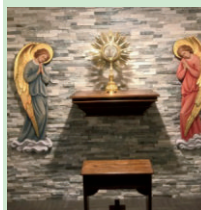
