

FROM FATHER TOM

On October 11th, we celebrated the feast of Saint Pope John XXIII. I came across his ten guidelines which he tried to live each day. I find them very helpful and so I wanted to share them with you. Perhaps they may enhance your life as well.

Daily Decalogue of St. John XXIII

- 1. Only for today, I will seek to live the livelong day positively without wishing to solve the problems of my life all at once.
- 2. Only for today, I will take the greatest care of my appearance: I will dress modestly; I will not raise my voice; I will be courteous in my behavior; I will not criticize anyone; I will not claim to improve or to discipline anyone except myself.
- 3. Only for today, I will be happy in the certainty that I was created to be happy, not only in the other world but also in this one.
- 4. Only for today, I will adapt to circumstances, without requiring all circumstances to be adapted to my own wishes.
- 5. Only for today, I will devote 10 minutes of my time to some good reading, remembering that just as food is necessary to the life of the body, so good reading is necessary to the life of the soul.
- 6. Only for today, I will do one good deed and not tell anyone about it.
- 7. Only for today, I will do at least one thing I do not like doing; and if my feelings are hurt, I will make sure that no one notices.
- 8. Only for today, I will make a plan for myself: I may not follow it to the letter, but I will make it. And I will be on guard against two evils: hastiness and indecision.
- 9. Only for today, I will firmly believe, despite appearances, that the good Providence of God cares for me as no one else who exists in this world.
- 10, Only for today, I will have no fears. In particular, I will not be afraid to enjoy what is beautiful and to believe in goodness. Indeed, for 12 hours I can certainly do what might cause me consternation were I to believe I had to do it all my life.

Decálogo diario de San Juan XXIII

- 1. Solo por hoy, procuraré vivir el día con optimismo, sin pretender resolver todos mis problemas de una vez.
- 2. Solo por hoy, cuidaré mi apariencia: vestiré con modestia; no alzaré la voz; seré cortés en mi comportamiento; no criticaré a nadie; no pretenderé mejorar ni disciplinar a nadie más que a mí mismo.
- 3. Solo por hoy, seré feliz con la certeza de que fui creado para ser feliz, no solo en el otro mundo, sino también en este.
- 4. Solo por hoy, me adaptaré a las circunstancias, sin exigir que todas las circunstancias se adapten a mis deseos. 5. Solo por hoy, dedicaré diez minutos a una buena lectura, recordando que así como el alimento es necesario para la vida del cuerpo, la buena lectura lo es para la vida del alma.
- 6. Solo por hoy, haré una buena acción y no se lo contaré a nadie.
- 7. Solo por hoy, haré al menos una cosa que no me guste; y si me siento herido, me aseguraré de que nadie lo note.
- 8. Solo por hoy, haré un plan: puede que no lo siga al pie de la letra, pero lo haré. Y estaré alerta ante dos males: la precipitación y la indecisión.
- 9. Solo por hoy, creeré firmemente, a pesar de las apariencias, que la bondadosa Providencia de Dios me cuida como a nadie más en este mundo.
- 10. Solo por hoy, no tendré miedos. En particular, no tendré miedo de disfrutar de la belleza y de creer en la bondad. De hecho, durante 12 horas puedo hacer sin duda lo que me causaría consternación si creyera que tengo que hacerlo toda la vida.





For those parishioners who did not get the opportunity to take an Angel Tag from our Christmas


