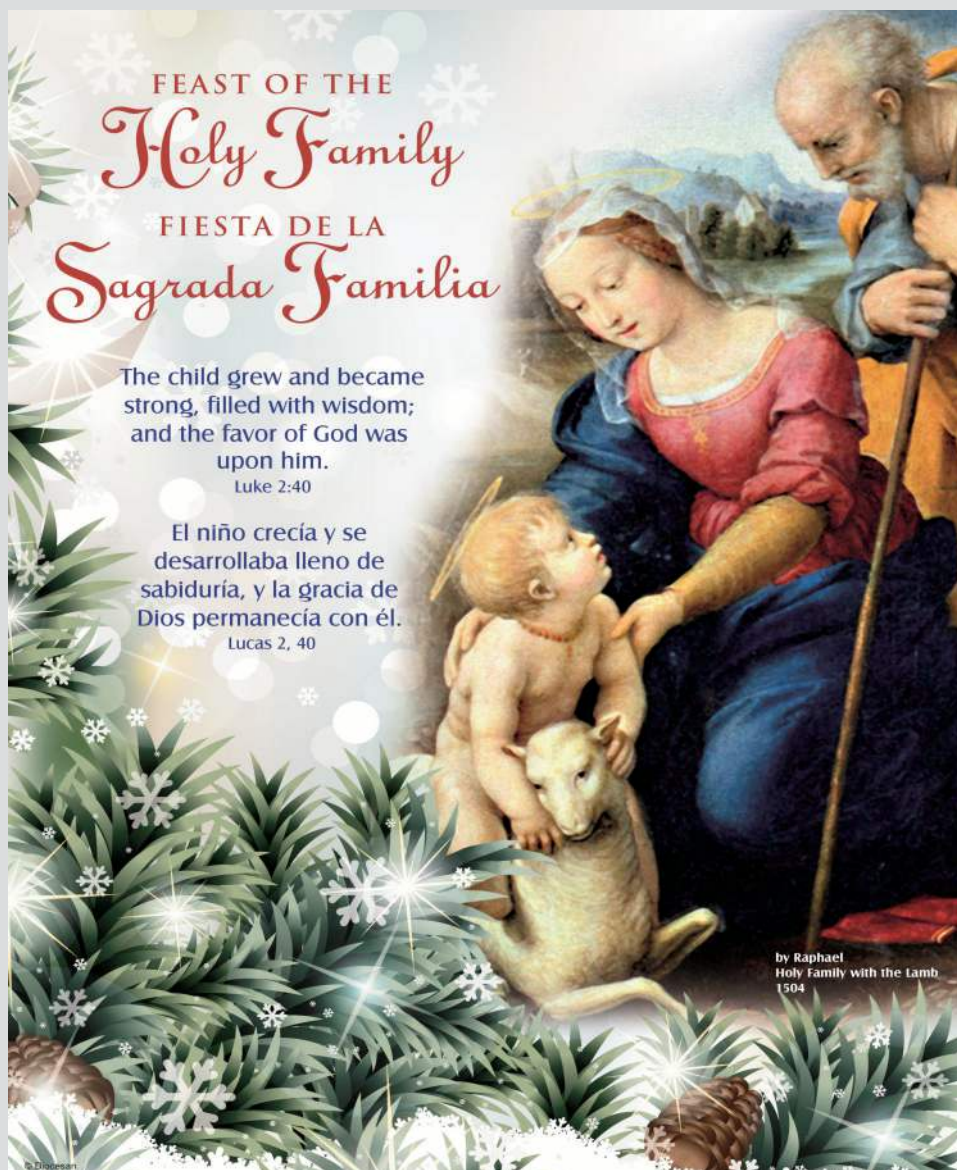

A **Grief Share** Group will begin again at 2:00 pm on **Wednesday, January 7, 2026** at St. Theresa's.

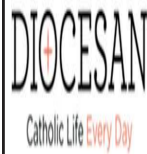
When a loved one dies, it can feel like you are all
