FROM FATHER TOM

I came across this inspiring story.

"A young man named Peter reminded me of a modern-day Philip. I stopped in to a McDonald's in Cambridge, Massachusetts, and I noticed Peter working the counter. I recognized him from our young adult ministry at church, and I knew he had just graduated from Harvard University with a master's degree. I greeted him and managed to get him to break free for coffee together.

"What are you doing here?" I asked, knowing that Harvard master's degree students don't usually aspire to work the counter at McDonald's. "Well," he explained, "I graduated in May but I went four months without finding a job, so I said to myself, 'I need some income to pay bills.' So this is where I've ended up—at least for now."

"Sorry to hear that. It must be hard," I replied, but Peter cut me off.

"No. Don't be sorry. God has me here. This place is giving me awesome opportunities to share my faith. I'm on a shift that includes a Buddhist guy from Sri Lanka, a Muslim fellow from Lebanon, a Hindu lady from India, and a fellow Christian from El Salvador. It's awesome. I get to be a global missionary to my coworkers while asking 'would you like fries with that?'"

A Harvard master's degree student working at McDonald's? It doesn't quite make sense. McDonald's is not the typical place we expect someone with an esteemed education. Then again Jesus getting baptized in the Jordan is not where we expect to find Jesus. What Jesus and the McDonald worker share in common is that they are both on a mission- bring others to the Father. Jesus becomes one of us in all ways except in sin to show us the way to the Father. Jesus is on a mission.

We too are on a mission- bring others to Christ. A survey of Catholic parishes produced this following surprisingly find. The number one desire of parishioners was not better music, more social events, or even bible studies. The number one request was help in evangelizing. They want to know how to bring others to Christ. That's what our baptism expects. We can do this. Keep it simple. Be a friend. Join your friend(s) in their activities. At the right time, invite them to your activity- going to church with you. Don't send them alone. Accompany them. We can do this. Be on a mission. We are living in an exciting time.

DEL PADRE TOM

Me encontré con esta historia inspiradora.

"Un joven llamado Peter me recordó a un Felipe de los tiempos modernos. Entré a un McDonald's en Cambridge, Massachusetts, y vi a Peter trabajando en el mostrador. Lo reconocí de nuestro ministerio de jóvenes adultos en la iglesia, y sabía que se acababa de graduar de la Universidad de Harvard con una maestría. Lo saludé y logré convencerlo para que tomáramos un café juntos.

"¿Qué haces aquí?", le pregunté, sabiendo que los estudiantes de maestría de Harvard no suelen aspirar a trabajar en el mostrador de un McDonald's. "Bueno", explicó, "me gradué en mayo, pero pasé cuatro meses sin encontrar trabajo, así que me dije: 'Necesito ingresos para pagar las cuentas'. Así que aquí es donde he terminado, al menos por ahora".

"Lamento oír eso. Debe ser difícil", respondí, pero Peter me interrumpió.

"No. No lo lamente. Dios me tiene aquí. Este lugar me está brindando oportunidades increíbles para compartir mi fe. Trabajo en un turno con un budista de Sri Lanka, un musulmán del Líbano, una hindú de la India y un compañero cristiano de El Salvador. Es genial." Puedo ser misionero global para mis compañeros de trabajo mientras les pregunto: "¿Quieren papas fritas con eso?".

¿Un estudiante de maestría de Harvard trabajando en McDonald's? No parece tener mucho sentido. McDonald's no es el lugar típico donde esperaríamos encontrar a alguien con una educación tan prestigiosa. Pero, de nuevo, el bautismo de Jesús en el Jordán tampoco es el lugar donde esperaríamos encontrarlo. Lo que Jesús y el empleado de McDonald's tienen en común es que ambos están en una misión: llevar a otros al Padre. Jesús se hizo uno de nosotros en todo, excepto en el pecado, para mostrarnos el camino al Padre. Jesús está en una misión.

Nosotros también estamos en una misión: llevar a otros a Cristo. Una encuesta realizada en parroquias católicas arrojó este sorprendente resultado: el principal deseo de los feligreses no era mejor música, más eventos sociales ni siquiera estudios bíblicos. La principal petición era ayuda para evangelizar. Quieren saber cómo llevar a otros a Cristo. Eso es lo que nuestro bautismo espera de nosotros. Podemos lograrlo. Mantengámoslo sencillo. Seamos amigos. Acompañemos a nuestros amigos en sus actividades. En el momento oportuno, invitemos a nuestras actividades, como ir a la iglesia con nosotros. No los envíemos solos. Acompañémoslos. Podemos hacerlo. Estemos en una misión. Vivimos en una época emocionante.







A Grief Share Group began on **Wednesday, January 7, 2026** at 2:00 pm. You can join at any time.


