FROM FATHER TOM

I came across this article in Aletelia. I said to myself 'this is what is happening here at St. Theresa!' Tradismatic! We have Praise and Worship with adoration Wednesday morning at 9. Our five o'clock Sunday evening mass (beginning November) fits the bill. Our Alleluia before the Gospel is not a typical response. We are a traditional church but with a Holy Spirit flavor. I had no idea it was a "thing." I thought it was just us. I pray that it is a sign that the Holy Spirit is with us.

Have you heard of the new "Tradismatic" spirituality? Philip Kosloski - published on 09/26/25

An increasing number of Catholics call themselves "Tradismatic" or "Trentecostal," seeking to fuse both tradition and charismatic spirituality. Over the centuries Catholics have felt called by the Holy Spirit to approach God in a variety of ways. St. Francis, for example, felt called by God to "rebuild my Church," which led to a spirituality of radical poverty and reliance on God's divine providence. His way of approaching God was never intended to be embraced by all people but was an open invitation to those who felt a similar desire to give up everything and follow Jesus Christ. Recently there has grown a new spiritual movement, especially among young people, that has created a new word: Tradismatic.

The word combines "traditional" and "charismatic" into a unique spirituality for the modern age. In an article for First Things, Clement Harrold wrote that, it is "a spiritual renewal that offers hope to the American Church: a unique blend of the 'traditional' and 'charismatic' liturgical-spiritual elements that in many other places are pitted against each other. It is a synthesis that appeals to head and heart alike, suggesting what the Church might become in the twenty-first century."

This spirituality has appealed to many young people, as it combines both traditional liturgy, and an openness to the movements of the Holy Spirit. While it does value the importance of tradition, it is not cut-off from what God is trying to speak to his people in the present day. Henri d'Anselme, a Catholic who is most well-known backpacking across France and stopping a knife attack, also explained this spirituality in an interview with Rod Dreher:

I have no problem going to both the Novus Ordo and the traditional Latin Mass. I prefer the Latin mass, but I don't care what kind of liturgy it is, if the priest really believes what he's doing, and people are being converted. I am part of a generation we call "tradismatic" — a mix of traditionalist and charismatic.

In some ways this spiritual movement is a response to what some may call "extremes" in both traditionalist and charismatic communities. It tries to achieve a healthy middle ground, having a deep respect for the traditions of the Church, while also not denying that God is actively working in the world today.

Often a "Tradismatic" Catholic loves a more traditional liturgy (it doesn't have to be the Latin Mass), while also being comfortable listening to praise and worship music. Like St. Francis' spirituality, it may not be for everyone, but it is likely to continue to gain ground. May the Lord be praised!

Me encontré con este artículo en Aletelia. Me dije a mí misma: "¡Esto es lo que está pasando aquí en Santa Teresa!". ¡Tradismático! Tenemos Alabanza y Adoración con adoración el miércoles por la mañana a las 9. Nuestra misa de las cinco de la tarde del domingo (a partir de noviembre) encaja perfectamente. Nuestro Aleluya antes del Evangelio no es una respuesta típica. Somos una iglesia tradicional, pero con un toque del Espíritu Santo. No tenía ni idea de que fuera algo común. Pensé que solo éramos nosotros. Rezo para que sea una señal de que el Espíritu Santo está con nosotros.

¿Has oído hablar de la nueva espiritualidad "Tradismática"? Philip Kosloski - publicado el 26/09/25

Un número creciente de católicos se autodenominan "Tradismáticos" o "Trentocostales", buscando fusionar la tradición y la espiritualidad carismática. A lo largo de los siglos, los católicos se han sentido llamados por el Espíritu Santo a acercarse a Dios de diversas maneras. San Francisco, por ejemplo, se sintió llamado por Dios a "reconstruir mi Iglesia", lo que dio lugar a una espiritualidad de pobreza radical y confianza en la divina providencia de Dios. Su forma de acercarse a Dios nunca pretendió ser adoptada por todas las personas, sino que fue una invitación abierta a quienes sentían un deseo similar de renunciar a todo y seguir a Jesucristo. Recientemente ha surgido un nuevo movimiento espiritual, especialmente entre los jóvenes, que ha creado una nueva palabra: Tradismático.

La palabra combina "tradicional" y "carismático" en una espiritualidad única para la era moderna. En un artículo para First Things, Clement Harrold escribió que es "una renovación espiritual que ofrece esperanza a la Iglesia estadounidense: una mezcla única de elementos litúrgicos y espirituales 'tradicionales' y 'carismáticos' que en muchos otros lugares se contraponen". Es una síntesis que apela tanto a la razón como al corazón, sugiriendo lo que la Iglesia podría llegar a ser en el siglo XXI.

Esta espiritualidad ha atraído a muchos jóvenes, ya que combina la liturgia tradicional con una apertura a la acción del Espíritu Santo. Si bien valora la importancia de la tradición, no se aísla de lo que Dios intenta comunicar a su pueblo en la actualidad.

Henri d'Anselme, un católico conocido por su viaje a pie por Francia y por haber detenido un ataque con cuchillo, también explicó esta espiritualidad en una entrevista con Rod Dreher:

No tengo problema en asistir tanto a la Misa del Novus Ordo como a la Misa tradicional en latín. Prefiero la Misa en latín, pero no me importa el tipo de liturgia, siempre que el sacerdote crea de verdad en lo que hace y que la gente se convierta. Pertenezco a una generación que llamamos "tradismática", una mezcla de tradicionalista y carismática.

En cierto modo, este movimiento espiritual es una respuesta a lo que algunos podrían llamar "extremos" tanto en las comunidades tradicionalistas como en las carismáticas. Busca un equilibrio saludable, con un profundo respeto por las tradiciones de la Iglesia, sin negar que Dios sigue actuando activamente en el mundo de hoy.

A menudo, un católico "tradismático" prefiere una liturgia más tradicional (no necesariamente la Misa en latín), a la vez que se siente cómodo escuchando música de alabanza y adoración. Al igual que la espiritualidad de San Francisco, puede que no sea para todos, pero es probable que siga ganando adeptos. ¡Alabado sea el Señor!


