



FROM FATHER TOM

They're hungry. We have taken it upon ourselves to feed the less fortunate here in Bellevue and beyond. God has placed this task upon us, and we gladly have said yes. We accept this responsibility. They depend on us. This is not a burden but a blessing. We get to do the work that the early church performed. In doing so we receive God's blessings. I try every day to thank God for allowing us to share in His mission. I thank Him for those who perform this work of charity. I ask the Lord to look favorably upon all those who donate food – be it Publix, Pizza Hut, Second Harvest, various churches, Del Webb, and all the individuals.

I am asking you to bring one or more food items each week, especially the first weekend of the month. Our contributions have dropped considerably. The shelves are bare. We need your help in this little act of kindness. "When I was hungry you fed me" (Matthew 25:35). Thank you to those who have been helping us out.

I want to share a story from Robert J. Wicks, a Catholic psychotherapist:

One night a man came to our house and told me, "There is a family with eight children. They have not eaten for days." I took some food with me and went. When I came to that family, I saw the faces of those little children disfigured by hunger. There was no sorrow or sadness on their faces, just the deep pain of hunger. I gave the rice to the mother. She divided the rice in two, and went out carrying half the rice. When she came back, I asked her, "Where did you go?" She gave me this simple answer, "To my neighbors, they are hungry also!" I was not surprised that she gave – poor people are really very generous. I was surprised that she knew they were hungry. As a rule, when we are suffering, we are so focused on ourselves, we have no time for others.

May we open our hearts to the hungry.



Quiero compartir una historia de Robert J. Wicks, un psicoterapeuta católico:

Una noche, un hombre vino a nuestra casa y me dijo: «Hay una familia con ocho hijos. No han comido en días». Tomé algo de comida y fui. Cuando llegué a la casa de esa familia, vi los rostros de esos pequeños desfigurados por el hambre. No había tristeza ni pesar en sus rostros, solo el profundo dolor del hambre. Le di el arroz a la madre. Ella dividió el arroz en dos y salió con la mitad. Cuando regresó, le pregunté: «¿Adónde fuiste?». Me dio esta sencilla respuesta: «A casa de mis vecinos, ¡ellos también tienen hambre!». No me sorprendió que compartiera; la gente pobre es realmente muy generosa. Me sorprendió que supiera que tenían hambre. Por lo general, cuando sufrimos, estamos tan concentrados en nosotros mismos que no tenemos tiempo para los demás.

Que abramos nuestros corazones a los hambrientos.


