

## *A Message from Fr. Tom*

### Weekly Letter to the Parish

#### **This Incredible Obituary May Be the Best Thing You Read All Week**

I came across this article years ago. It is both touching and humorous. It also speaks of a time long gone by, unfortunately so. As we celebrate the arrival of spring, may it put a bounce in your step and a smile on your face. If you're about to throw away an old pair of pantyhose, stop and consider Mary Agnes Mullaney (you probably knew her as "Pink"), who entered eternal life on Sunday, September 1, 2013. Her spirit lives on through her six children, 17 grandchildren, three surviving siblings in New "Joisey," and an extended family of relatives and friends from every walk of life.

We were blessed to learn many valuable lessons from Pink during her 85 years, among them: never throw away old pantyhose. Use the old ones to tie gutters, childproof cabinets, secure toilet flappers, or hang Christmas ornaments.

Also: if a possum takes up residence in your shed, grab a barbecue brush to coax him out. If he doesn't leave, brush him for twenty minutes and let him stay.

Let a dog (or two or three) share your bed. Say the rosary while you walk them. Go to church with a chicken sandwich in your purse. Cry at the consecration every time. Then give the chicken sandwich to your homeless friend after Mass.

Go to a nursing home and kiss everyone. When you learn someone's name, share the story of their patron saint and their feast day so they can celebrate. Invite new friends to Thanksgiving dinner. If they are from another country and you have trouble understanding them, learn to "listen with an accent."

Never say mean things about anybody. They are "poor souls to pray for." Put picky-eating children in the box at the bottom of the laundry chute. Tell them they are hungry lions in a cage and feed them vegetables through the slats.

Correspond with the imprisoned and have lunch with the cognitively challenged.

Do the Jumble every morning.

Keep the car keys under the front seat so they don't get lost. Make the car dance by lightly tapping the brakes to the beat of songs on the radio.

Offer rides to people carrying a heavy load or caught in the rain or summer heat. Believe the hitchhiker you pick up who says he is a landscaper and his name is "Peat Moss."

Help anyone struggling to get their children into a car or shopping cart, or across a parking lot.

Give to every charity that asks. Choose to believe the best about what they do with your money, no matter what your children say they discovered online.



In her lifetime, Pink made connections time and time again. Those who have taken her lessons to heart will continue to make sure a cold drink is left for the overheated garbage collector and mail carrier, every baby is kissed, every nursing home resident is visited, the hungry receive a sandwich, the guest finds a warm bed and a soft nightlight, and the encroaching possum knows the soothing sensation of a barbecue brush upon its back.

Above all, Pink wrote to everyone about everything. You may read this and recall a letter from her that touched your heart, tickled your funny bone, or perhaps made you say, "Huh?" She is survived by her children and grandchildren, whose photos she would proudly share with prospective friends in the checkout line. Pink is reunited with her husband and favorite dance and political debate partner, Dr. Gerald L. Mullaney, and was predeceased by six siblings. What a beautiful life.

May you, too, be a blessing.
