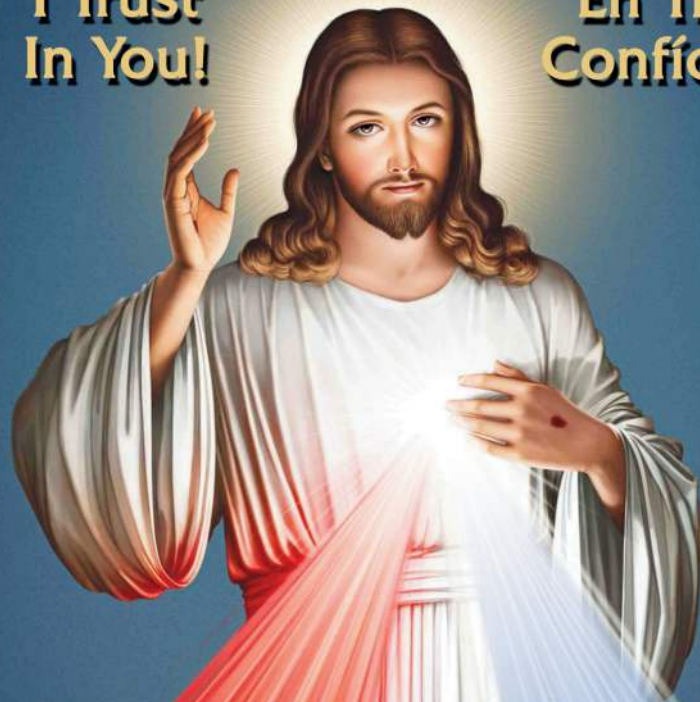

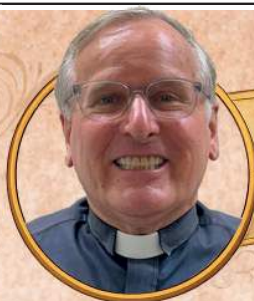

**A Message from Fr. Tom**

**Divine Mercy Sunday**

Happy Divine Mercy Sunday! We had a wonderful Easter and now we celebrate this wonderful feast which falls on the Sunday after Easter. The origins of Divine Mercy go back during the rise of Nazism and the reign of Hitler. The message and devotion to Jesus as The Divine Mercy is based on the writings of Saint Faustina Kowalska, an uneducated Polish nun who, in obedience to her spiritual director, wrote a diary of about 600 pages recording the revelations she received about God's mercy. Even before her death in 1938, the devotion to The Divine Mercy had begun to spread. Pope John Paul II had great affinity towards this devotion and authorized it in the Liturgical Calendar of the Roman Catholic Church. Today it is celebrated throughout the world.

The Divine Mercy message is one we can call to mind simply by remembering ABC:

**A** - Ask for His Mercy. God wants us to approach Him in prayer constantly, repenting of our sins and asking Him to pour His mercy out upon us and upon the whole world.

**B** - Be merciful. God wants us to receive His mercy and let it flow through us to others. He wants us to extend love and forgiveness to others just as He does to us.

**C** - Completely trust in Jesus. God wants us to know that all the graces of His mercy can only be received by our trust. The more we open the door of our hearts and lives to Him with trust, the more we can receive.

Please join us as we honor our Lord and seek His mercy for ourselves and our world.

**Domingo de la Divina Misericordia**

¡Feliz Domingo de la Divina Misericordia! Tuvimos una Pascua maravillosa y ahora celebramos esta hermosa festividad que cae el domingo después de Pascua. Los orígenes de la Divina Misericordia se remontan al surgimiento del nazismo y el reinado de Hitler. El mensaje y la devoción a Jesús como La Divina Misericordia se basa en los escritos de Santa Faustina Kowalska, una monja polaca quien escribió un diario de aproximadamente 600 páginas donde registró las revelaciones que recibió sobre la misericordia de Dios. El Papa Juan Pablo II tuvo gran afinidad hacia esta devoción y la autorizó en el Calendario Litúrgico de la Iglesia Católica Romana. Hoy se celebra en todo el mundo.

El mensaje de la Divina Misericordia lo podemos recordar fácilmente con el ABC:

**A** - Pide Su Misericordia. Dios quiere que nos acerquemos a Él constantemente en oración, arrepintiéndonos de nuestros pecados y pidiéndole que derrame Su misericordia sobre nosotros y sobre el mundo entero.

**B** - Sé misericordioso. Dios quiere que recibamos Su misericordia y la dejemos fluir a través de nosotros hacia los demás. Quiere que extendamos amor y perdón a otros así como Él lo hace con nosotros.

**C** - Confía completamente en Jesús. Dios quiere que sepamos que todas las gracias de Su misericordia solo pueden recibirse mediante nuestra confianza. Cuanto más abramos la puerta de nuestros corazones y vidas a Él con confianza, más podremos recibir.

Acompáñenos a honrar a nuestro Señor y a buscar Su misericordia para nosotros y para nuestro mundo. El domingo a las 3 p.m. Al fin y al cabo, ¿quién no necesita la misericordia de Dios?

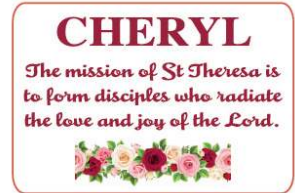
